



IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR CRUISE

ICELAND EMBARKATION

Effective from July 22, 2021

The information included in this document is based on current Iceland regulations and the protocols outlined in the Viking Health & Safety Program. Requirements may change on an ongoing basis and may be updated before your departure. **Please recheck this information at least 7 days prior to your departure for any changes to requirements.**

TO TRAVEL TO ICELAND, YOU WILL NEED:

1. Valid Passport (must be valid for 6 months beyond your planned trip dates) and valid residency visa (for UK guests)
2. Original CDC COVID-19 Vaccination Record Card (US)/NHS COVID Letter (UK) - proof of full vaccination with FDA/WHO Approved Vaccine (received at least 14 days prior to departure), including Moderna (Moderna), Pfizer-BioNTech (Comirnaty), Johnson & Johnson (Janssen) or AstraZeneca/Oxford (Covishield, Vaxzevria).
3. Negative COVID-19 PCR test result
4. Iceland [Pre-registration and Health Declaration](#) form confirmation email with barcode (print or have available on phone)

WHAT YOU NEED TO DO BEFORE YOU GO:

To ensure you have completed the necessary steps to travel, we have prepared the following countdown timeline.

Days Prior to Departure	Items to Complete Prior to Travel
As soon as possible	Ensure your passport is valid for at least 6 months beyond your trip date . As always, we recommend you purchase travel insurance to protect your investment and ensure you have appropriate medical coverage for any unforeseen incidents during your journey.
14	Receive your final FDA/WHO approved COVID-19 vaccine dose. All Viking sailings will be available exclusively for vaccinated guests.
10	Complete VeriFLY Vaccine Certification following the steps outlined here .
7 to 5	Complete and submit the Viking Digital Health Survey to confirm you have not been exposed to COVID-19. You will receive an email with a link to complete the survey, which will be available at www.myvikingjourney.com and submitted directly to Viking once completed.
5	Last Day to Complete Digital Health Survey on www.myvikingjourney.com
No more than 3 days prior	<p>(Effective for arrivals after midnight on July 26, local time.*) Get a COVID-19 PCR Test (nasopharyngeal/nasal swab) 72 hours prior to your departure to Iceland. Ensure you are provided with either a printed and/or electronic copy of the results; be prepared to present this multiple times as directed throughout your travels.</p> <p>IMPORTANT: You must have a COVID-19 PCR Test (nasopharyngeal/nasal swab, polymerase chain reaction test) - either RT or Rapid PCR. The COVID-19 PCR test cannot be an antigen or antibody test. You will be asked to present your negative test results before you board your flight.</p> <p>*Note: As travel requirements change frequently, for your peace of mind and to ensure you are prepared, we recommend you take a COVID-19 PCR (polymerase chain reaction, nasopharyngeal/nasal swab test) within 72 hours of your arrival in Iceland.</p>
No more than 3 days and at least 1 days prior	<p>Fill out your Iceland Pre-registration forms, no more than 72 hours prior to arrival in Iceland, you will be required to complete the Pre-registration Form at https://visit.covid.is/registration/.</p> <p>Step 1: Health Declaration and mobile phone verification. You will be asked for your mobile number and will be required to request a verification number before you can continue. Before your flight	<p>Assemble your Health/Travel Documents</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Valid Passport Passport must be valid for 6 months beyond your planned trip dates (#1 above) UK guests: Valid residency visa (in addition to valid passport) • Proof of Full Vaccination with FDA/WHO Approved Vaccine US guests: Original CDC COVID-19 Vaccination Record Card. (#2 above) UK guests: Printed version of the NHS COVID letter. • Printed and electronic copy of your COVID-19 PCR negative test result (#3 above). Note: You will need this to board your flight and upon arrival in Iceland. • Printed (or available on phone) Iceland Pre-registration form confirmation barcode. (#4 above). • Your cruise documents and air tickets (emailed to you by Viking) <p>Tip: While digital documents on your phone are accepted, they may slow your clearance through the checkpoints in the Iceland arrival terminal, so we suggest printing your documentation and having it available throughout your journey.</p>

Health/Travel Documents: Please remember to bring the appropriate travel and health documents when you travel.

Embarkation Procedure (Iceland): Upon arrival, you may be required to take a COVID-19 test administered by the Icelandic government. This test will be in addition to the embarkation test required by Viking.

Special Note: The ship is designated as an Iceland quarantine area for Viking guests. If you took a COVID-19 PCR test at the airport, you will be transferred to your ship as you await confirmation of a negative COVID-19 PCR test result. You will then proceed to your stateroom where you will be required to provide a saliva sample for a second onboard COVID-19 PCR test. Please refrain from consuming any food or beverage item or smoking for at least one hour before submitting your saliva sample. While waiting for your test results, you will be able to use the public spaces on board observing current mask and social distancing requirements.

You will also need to undergo the following COVID-19 screening prior to your cruise:

- Temperature check (a temperature reading of less than 100.4°F/38°C).
- Questions in relation to your general health, COVID-19 symptoms, or possible exposure.
- Accept and agree to using contact-tracing technology during your cruise.
- Complete any required check-in procedures.

During Your Cruise: You will be tested periodically, on board the ship, as required by Viking and in coordination with the government of Iceland.

Disembarkation/Return Flight: Prior to leaving your Viking ship, you will be required to take a final COVID-19 test to satisfy the requirement for pre-flight testing before arrival in your country.

About Health and Safety Protocols on Your Journey: In addition to each destination’s government regulations, additional protocols within the Viking Health & Safety Program have been implemented to protect our guests and crew.
