



IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR CRUISE

ITALY EMBARKATION (US, Canadian, UK, AU, and NZ guests)

Effective from November 30, 2021

The information included in this document is based on current regulations and the protocols outlined in the Viking Health & Safety Program. Requirements may change on an ongoing basis and may be updated before your departure.

Please recheck this information at least 7 days prior to your departure for any changes.

TO TRAVEL WITH VIKING:

- Valid Passport** (must be valid for 6 months beyond your planned trip dates)
- Proof of full COVID-19 vaccination – certified by VeriFLY** with FDA/WHO/EMA Approved Vaccine (received at least 14 days prior to departure), including Moderna (Moderna), Pfizer-BioNTech (Comirnaty), Johnson & Johnson (Janssen) or AstraZeneca/Oxford (Vaxzevria)
Note: Starting December 15, guests over the age of 65 who have received their second shot or single-dose vaccine more than 6 months ago **will need a booster shot** to travel to France.
- Cruise Documents/Journey Summary**

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS TO TRAVEL TO ITALY:

- Proof of negative COVID-19 PCR**
 - If traveling from US/Canada/AU/NZ, taken no more than **72 hours prior to arrival in Italy**.
 - If traveling from UK, taken no more than **48 hours prior to arrival in Italy**.

Important: If you are traveling independently and have made your own air arrangements, please ensure that you have checked local requirements for your arrival port and contacted your air carrier for their requirements. Additionally, if you are traveling independently, outside of your home country and before your first Viking activity – embarking ship or joining a pre-extension – PCR test must be taken 72 hours prior to your first Viking activity.

WHAT YOU NEED TO DO BEFORE YOU GO:

| As soon as possible | Ensure your passport is valid for at least 6 months beyond your trip date. We recommend you purchase travel insurance to protect your investment and ensure you have appropriate medical coverage for any unforeseen incidents during your journey. Starting December 15, guests over the age of 65 who have received their final vaccine dose more than 6 months ago will need a booster shot to travel to France. |
| 14 | Receive your final FDA/WHO/EMA approved COVID-19 vaccine dose. All Viking sailings will be available exclusively for vaccinated guests. |

| 10 | Complete VeriFLY Vaccine Certification following the steps outlined <i>here</i> . |
| 5-7 | Complete and submit the Viking Digital Health Survey to confirm you have not been exposed to COVID-19. You will receive an email with a link to complete the survey, which will be available at www.myvikingjourney.com and submitted directly to Viking once completed. As part of the Viking Health & Safety Program , you are required to complete a Digital Health Questionnaire 5-7 days prior to arriving at your first Viking destination, either the day you check in at a hotel with Viking or embark on a Viking ship. This health survey is available 7 days prior to your departure date. |
| No more than 3 | <p>Get a COVID-19 PCR Test– Italy REQUIREMENT</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • US/Canadian guests must get a test no more than 72 hours prior to arrival in Italy. • UK guests must get a test no more than 48 hours prior to arrival in Italy. <p>Ensure you are provided with either a printed and/or electronic copy of the results; be prepared to present this multiple times as directed throughout your travels. Italy requires a PCR test for guests from US, Canada and UK.</p> |
| 3 | <p>Fill out the Italy Passenger Locator Form (EU PLF) at least 3 days prior to arrival in Italy. You can find the form at https://app.euplf.eu/#/form. One form must be completed for each adult passenger</p> <p>Register: This will require an email and a password. Once you click “Register” an account activation link will be emailed to you. As soon as you click on the link, your account is activated.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Agree to terms and conditions: YES • Choose your destination: Italy • Choose transportation type: Aircraft • You will be asked: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Is your flight: Direct/Non-Direct ○ Are you traveling as a member of a group/with your family? Once you have reviewed, SUBMIT the form.</p> <p>You will receive an email confirming the form was successfully completed. Click on the link in the email to view/print/download the PLF (Passenger Locator Form).</p> <p>Please download and print the completed/submitted PDF forms with the QR code or have it available on your mobile device. You may be required to present these forms before you board your flight and will be required to present forms before you exit the airport terminal. If you do not have the appropriate Passenger Locator Form, at the airport of departure, you may be denied boarding.</p> |

| Before your flight | <p>Assemble your Travel Documents</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Valid Passport, must be valid for 6 months beyond your trip date • Proof of Full Vaccination with FDA/WHO/EMA Approved Vaccine <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • VeriFLY COVI-19 vaccine verification and your original CDC COVID-19 Vaccination Record Card (US) or Government approved card for Canadian guests • Italy Passenger Locator Form (EU-PLF) (#3 above), printed copy as well as electronic version. • Printed and electronic copies of your negative COVID-19 PCR test result (Italy requirement) • Your cruise documents and air tickets. <p>FOR UK GUESTS ONLY: PRIOR TO LEAVING THE UK</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Prior to travel you must arrange your COVID-19 test which must be taken before the end of day 2 after your return home to the UK. This must be a privately purchased test through a government approved provider and not an NHS lateral flow test. EMBARKATION PROCEDURE: After passing through all the document verification checkpoints (e.g., customs, immigration), you will be transferred to your ship. You will then proceed to your stateroom where you will be required to provide a saliva sample. Please refrain from consuming any food or beverage item or smoking for at least one hour before submitting your saliva sample. While waiting for your test results, you will be able to use the public spaces on board observing current mask and social distancing requirements.

You will also need to undergo the following COVID-19 screening prior to your cruise:

- Temperature check (a temperature reading of less than 100.4°F/38°C).
- Questions in relation to your general health, COVID-19 symptoms, or possible exposure.
- Accept and agree to using contact-tracing technology during your cruise.
- Complete any required check-in procedures.

DURING YOUR CRUISE: You will have periodic COVID-19 tests (via non-invasive saliva samples) on board as required by Viking and/or any countries through which we sail. **You should also have your mask, proof of vaccination and passport with you in case it is needed.**

Independent Exploration: Due to local restrictions, **some cities in Italy do not allow independent exploration at this time.** However, guests may explore independently in other countries while following the requirements in the country they are visiting. Please note, conditions and restrictions continue to change and vary by country. The ability to explore ashore independently may change at the time of your visit.

DISSEMBARKATION/RETURN FLIGHT: Prior to leaving your Viking ship, you will be required to take a final COVID-19 test to satisfy the requirement for pre-flight testing before arrival in your country. ADD return links to Canada and US – with requirements.
