



IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR CRUISE

SPAIN EMBARKATION (US, Canadian, UK, AU and NZ guests)

Effective from November 30, 2021

The information included in this document is based on current regulations and the protocols outlined in the Viking Health & Safety Program. Requirements may change on an ongoing basis and may be updated before your departure.

Please recheck this information at least 7 days prior to your departure for any changes.

TO TRAVEL WITH VIKING:

- 1. Valid Passport** (must be valid for 6 months beyond your planned trip dates).
- 2. Proof of full COVID-19 vaccination – certified by VeriFLY** with FDA/WHO/EMA Approved Vaccine (received at least 14 days prior to departure), including Moderna (Moderna), Pfizer-BioNTech (Comirnaty), Johnson & Johnson (Janssen), Sinopharm (Hayat-Vax), Sinovac-CoronaVac, or AstraZeneca/Oxford (Vaxzevria).
Note: Starting December 15, guests over the age of 65 who have received their second shot or single-dose vaccine more than 6 months ago **will need a booster shot** to travel to France.
- 3. Proof of negative COVID-19 PCR** – taken within 72 hours of boarding first outbound flight from home country/home.
- 4. Cruise Documents/Journey Summary**

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS TO TRAVEL TO SPAIN:

Note: As travel requirements change frequently, for your peace of mind and to ensure you are prepared, **Viking now REQUIRES you take a COVID-19 PCR (polymerase chain reaction) test** within 72 hours of boarding your first outbound flight from your home country/home. Be prepared to present negative test results throughout your journey, including upon arrival to your ship or your pre-cruise hotel program.

Important: If you are traveling independently and have made your own air arrangements, please ensure that you have checked local requirements for your arrival port and contacted your air carrier for their requirements. Additionally, if you are traveling independently, outside of your home country and before your first Viking activity – embarking ship or joining a pre-extension – PCR test must be taken 72 hours prior to your first Viking activity.

WHAT YOU NEED TO DO BEFORE YOU GO:

To ensure you have completed the necessary steps to travel, we have prepared the following countdown timeline. See <https://travelsafe.spain.info/en/> for additional information.

Days Prior to Departure	Description
As soon as possible	Ensure your passport is valid for at least 6 months beyond your trip date. We recommend you purchase travel insurance to protect your investment and ensure you have appropriate medical coverage for any unforeseen incidents during your journey. Starting December 15, guests over the age of 65 who have received their final vaccine dose more than 6 months ago will need a booster shot to travel to France.
14	Receive your final FDA/WHO approved COVID-19 vaccine dose. All Viking sailings will be available

	exclusively for vaccinated guests.
10-30	Complete VeriFLY Vaccine Certification following the steps outlined here .
5-7	Complete and submit the Viking Digital Health Survey to confirm you have not been exposed to COVID-19. You will receive an email with a link to complete the survey, which will be available at www.myvikingjourney.com and submitted directly to Viking once completed. As part of the Viking Health & Safety Program , you are required to complete a Digital Health Questionnaire 5-7 days prior to arriving at your first Viking destination, either the day you check in at a hotel with Viking or embark on a Viking ship. This health survey is available 7 days prior to your departure date.
3	Get a COVID-19 PCR Test within 72 hours of boarding your first outbound flight from your home country/home. Ensure you are provided with either a printed and/or electronic copy of the results. Be prepared to present this multiple times as directed throughout your travels, including when you join your ship, or your Viking pre-cruise hotel program. Viking is committed to doing all we can to ensure you are healthy and well prepared for international travel—and that you will be able to arrive in your destination and embark your ship without incident.
2	Before departure, complete your Spain Health Control Form and obtain your document control QR Code. This code must be presented at boarding and health controls upon arrival in Spain with your proof of vaccination. Submit your form no more than 48 hours before your flight. To fill out the form, you will need: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Passport Number 2. International transport information (arrival date, seat and flight number/name of the ship, company/airline, etc.) 3. Information on your stay in Spain, (<i>with some notes to consider about this part of the form: "Viking," "Catalonia" for the City or Province, "Barcelona" for the next two boxes</i>) 4. Email address 5. A document certifying your vaccination against, diagnosis of, or recovery from COVID-19, except children under 12. (<i>Here are some notes to consider when completing this section: Choose "OTHER," enter where you received your vaccination, your type of vaccination, and your date of vaccination.</i>) To create the form, fill out the initial information. Once you send the Health Control Form, you will receive an email with a security code and link associated with your trip that will allow you to obtain your QR code. If you have a traveling partner or are traveling with a family member, they can complete the form after you by clicking "new form." Each passenger will receive and requires their own QR code. Please download and print the completed forms with the QR code or have it available on your mobile device. You will be required to present these forms before you board your flight and before you exit the airport terminal in multiple areas. If you do not have the appropriate Health Control Form, at the airport of departure, you may be denied boarding.
Before your flight	Assemble your Travel Documents <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Valid Passport, must be valid for 6 months beyond your trip date (#1 above) • Proof of Full Vaccination with FDA/WHO Approved Vaccine <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • VeriFLY COVID-19 Vaccine Verification for Viking and your original CDC COVID-19 Vaccination Record Card (US) or printed version of the NHS COVID letter (UK) or government approved vaccination record (Canada) (#2 above) • Spain Travel Health Control Form QR Code (#3 above), printed copy as well as electronic version • Printed and electronic copies of your negative COVID-19 PCR test result (Required for all guests) • Viking Cruise Documents/Journey Summary • Airline Tickets FOR UK GUESTS ONLY: PRIOR TO LEAVING THE UK <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Prior to travel you must arrange your COVID-19 test which must be taken before the end of day 2 after</i>

	<p><i>your return home to the UK. This must be a privately purchased test through a government approved provider and not an NHS lateral flow test. Prior to travel for further information and updates, please visit the Foreign & Commonwealth Development Office (FCDO) here.</i></p>
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EMBARKATION PROCEDURE: After passing through all the document verification checkpoints (e.g., customs, immigration) there will be a health security check at your first point of entry. This will include at least a temperature check, document check and a visual assessment of your state of health. Once you complete the health security check, you will be transferred to your ship. You will then proceed to your stateroom where you will be required to provide a saliva sample. Please refrain from consuming any food or beverage item or smoking for at least one hour before submitting your saliva sample. While waiting for your test results, you will be able to use the public spaces on board observing current mask and social distancing requirements.

You will also need to undergo the following COVID-19 screening prior to your cruise:

- Temperature check (a temperature reading of less than 100.4°F/38°C).
- Questions in relation to your general health, COVID-19 symptoms, or possible exposure.
- Accept and agree to using contact-tracing technology during your cruise.
- Complete any required check-in procedures.

DURING YOUR CRUISE: You will have periodic COVID-19 tests (via non-invasive saliva samples) on board as required by Viking and/or any countries through which we sail. You should also have your mask, proof of vaccination and passport with you in case it is needed.

Independent Exploration: At this time, guests are able to explore on shore independently while following the requirements in the country they are visiting. However, conditions and restrictions continue to change and vary by country. The ability to explore ashore independently may change at the time of your visit.

DISSEMBARKATION/RETURN FLIGHT: Prior to leaving your Viking ship, you will be required to take a final COVID-19 test to satisfy the requirement for pre-flight testing before arrival in your country.

All guests should ensure they understand their countries re-entry requirements prior to leaving for your trip, see below for reference.
