



## IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR CRUISE

### RHINE GETAWAY (US GUESTS)

Effective from September 21, 2021

The information below is based on current regulations for the country/countries on this itinerary and the protocols outlined in the Viking Health & Safety Program. Requirements change on an ongoing basis and may be updated before your departure. **Please recheck this information regularly prior to your departure for any changes.**

#### TO TRAVEL ON THIS JOURNEY, YOU WILL NEED:

1. A valid passport (must be valid for 6 months beyond your planned trip dates).
2. Proof of full vaccination by the time of departure with FDA/WHO approved COVID-19 vaccine, including Moderna, Pfizer-BioNTech (Comirnaty), Johnson & Johnson (Janssen) or AstraZeneca/Oxford (Covishield, Vaxzevria). You are considered fully vaccinated two weeks after your second shot of the Moderna, Pfizer-BioNTech or AstraZeneca/Oxford vaccine, or four weeks after the single-dose Johnson & Johnson vaccine.
3. Entry requirements for European countries are changing regularly. Although several countries do not require a negative COVID-19 test result for entry, **Viking now requires that all our guests get a COVID-19 PCR test 72 hours prior to departure, unless it is already required by the country for entry** (see chart below; note the Netherlands requires a PCR test 48 hours prior to departure, and Italy 72 hours prior to arrival). *This applies to all departures Sep 23 through Oct 31, 2021; for the Netherlands from Sep 4 through Oct 31, 2021. Future departures to be determined.* This reduces your likelihood of being delayed, denied entry due to changing regulations, or positive (asymptomatic) test results on arrival. Should you or your immediate travel companion have a positive test result, you will not be able to travel as scheduled; please contact your Travel Advisor or Viking, so we can reschedule you.
4. Applicable passenger Locator or entry forms (details below)

#### WHAT YOU NEED TO DO BEFORE YOU GO:

To ensure you have completed the necessary steps to travel, we have prepared the following countdown timeline.

Days Prior to Departure	Description
As soon as possible	Ensure your <b>passport</b> is valid for at least 6 months beyond your trip date. We recommend you purchase <b>travel insurance</b> to protect your investment and ensure you have appropriate medical coverage for any unforeseen incidents during your journey.
14 (28 for J&J)	Receive your final <b>FDA/WHO approved COVID-19 vaccine</b> dose. All Viking sailings will be available exclusively for vaccinated guests.
10	Complete <b>VeriFLY Vaccine Certification</b> following the steps outlined <a href="#">here</a> .
7	Complete and submit the <b>Viking Digital Health Survey</b> to confirm you have not been exposed to COVID-19. You will receive an email with a link to complete the survey, which will be available at <a href="http://www.myvikingjourney.com">www.myvikingjourney.com</a> and submitted directly to Viking once completed.
Not more than 3	<b>If you are starting in the UK</b> , get a <b>COVID-19 PCR Test</b> (nasal swab) 72 hours prior to departure. Ensure you are provided either a printed and/or electronic copy of the results—texts are not acceptable. <b>If you are starting in Italy</b> , get a <b>COVID-19 PCR Test</b> (nasal swab) 72 hours prior to <u>arrival</u> . Ensure you are provided either a printed and/or electronic copy of the results—texts are not acceptable. <b>Even if none of the above apply, you must get a COVID-19 PCR Test</b> (nasal swab) <b>to satisfy Viking requirements</b> 72 hours prior to departure (48 hours for the Netherlands), with a printed and/or electronic copy of the results (not a text).

2	<p><b>Complete a Passenger Locator Card</b>, based on where your cruise or pre-cruise hotel extension starts.</p> <p><b>If your cruise starts in AMSTERDAM:</b> Get a <b>COVID-19 PCR Test</b> (nasal swab) not more than <b>48 hours</b> prior to departure. Ensure you are provided either a printed and/or electronic copy of the results—texts are not acceptable. Download the <b>Public Health Declaration</b> form (formerly the Dutch entry form) by clicking <a href="#">here</a>. Open this downloaded form, print it, fill it out, sign and take it with you when you fly out.</p> <p><b>If your cruise starts in BASEL, or you have a pre-extension (hotel) in Basel or Lucerne:</b> Complete the Swiss form at <a href="https://swissplf.admin.ch/formular">https://swissplf.admin.ch/formular</a>. Indicate you are arriving by plane (if you don't yet have a seat number, put in a temporary one and you will get an email link to update this once you know; this is for contact tracing). Under "Address of stay in Switzerland" select: "Other address of stay in Switzerland". <b>If you are going directly to the ship</b>, for Street, use "St. Johannis-Rheinweg"; for No., use "109"; for Postcode, use "4056"; for City, use "Basel"; Under Location of stay, use "Ship". <b>If you are in a hotel</b>, use the hotel address listed in your cruise e-documents under "Your Pre-Cruise Hotel Accommodations". You will receive an email with a QR code; Print this; bring with you.</p> <p><b>If booked on the LAKE COMO (Italy) pre-cruise (hotel)</b>, complete online Passenger Locator Form for Italy here: <a href="https://app.euplf.eu">https://app.euplf.eu</a>. On "Transportation Type" page, select "Aircraft". On the Aircraft Flight Information page, "Final Destination (Airport)," select "Varese Milano Malpensa/LIMC". On Temporary Address page, use the hotel address listed in your cruise e-documents under "Your Pre-Cruise Hotel Accommodations". On "Declaration" page, in the field "I will enter in the following Italian Region," select: Lombardia/25. You will receive an email with a QR code. Print and bring it with you. Once in Lake Como, check with your Viking Host for any additional forms needed.</p> <p><b>If you are booked on a UK pre-cruise extension</b>, book your day 2 PCR self-test and fill out your Passenger Locator Form: <a href="https://provide-journey-contact-details.homeoffice.gov.uk/passengerLocatorFormUserAccountCreationQuestion">https://provide-journey-contact-details.homeoffice.gov.uk/passengerLocatorFormUserAccountCreationQuestion</a>.</p>
Before your flight	<p><b>Assemble your Travel Documents</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Valid Passport, must be valid for 6 months beyond your trip date.</li> <li>• Proof of Full Vaccination with FDA/WHO Approved Vaccine—in most cases, this will be your CDC COVID-19 Vaccination Record Card</li> <li>• Your negative PCR test results.</li> <li>• The appropriate Passenger Locator or entry form that you printed out.</li> <li>• If starting in the UK, your day 2 PCR test booking confirmation.</li> <li>• Your cruise documents and air tickets, and a copy of this document.</li> </ul>

## WHAT TO EXPECT WHEN YOU ARRIVE:

**Airport Arrival in Destination:** After clearing all the document verification checkpoints (e.g., customs, immigration) and completing a routine temperature check, proceed to meet the Viking staff at baggage claim, who will assist you in transferring to the ship (or hotel for pre-cruise extensions).

**At Your Hotel (if applicable):** Check in to your hotel; a Viking Host will be available during business hours to assist you with any questions. Depending on your extension, you may be asked to complete a COVID-19 test (via non-invasive saliva sample).

**Embarkation:** Upon embarking your ship, your temperature will be automatically scanned by a non-invasive infrared camera (for a reading of less than 100.4°F/38°C), and you will be asked to supply a non-invasive saliva test sample for your COVID-19 PCR test. You may also be asked questions relevant to your general health, COVID-19 symptoms or possible exposure. You will need to accept and agree to contact-tracing procedures while traveling with Viking.

**During Your Cruise:** You will have periodic COVID-19 tests (via non-invasive saliva samples) on board as required by Viking and/or any countries through which we sail. You should also have your mask, proof of vaccination and passport with you in case it is needed; your cruise staff will inform you of any such requirements and will handle the paperwork for border crossings.

**Disembarkation/Return Flight:** To satisfy your pre-flight COVID-19 PCR test requirement for your return home, prior to leaving your Viking ship you will take a final COVID-19 PCR test (via non-invasive saliva sample). [If you have a post-cruise extension that would be longer than the 72-hour pre-flight requirement, you will take this COVID-19 PCR test at the hotel]. *Please note if you are continuing independently, you are responsible for getting your own COVID-19 test prior to departure; tests are readily available across Europe.*

**About Health and Safety Protocols on your Journey:** In addition to each destination's government regulations, additional protocols within the Viking Health & Safety Program have been implemented to protect our guests and crew.
